



How We are Keeping Our Dancers Safe Changes at The Dance Workshop for our 2020/2021 Season

At the Dance Workshop, our studio's physical layout lends its self to keeping our students and faculty safe. Each studio has its own entrance, washroom and lobby for student's belongings. There are no common areas shared between studios. We are implementing the following changes for September and will update our studio environment to reflect the most up to date recommendations provided by Health Canada.

- Online check-in for classes via our free studio app
- Parents to complete a mandatory COVID-19 screening form for their dancer on the app before classes, including temperature checks (teacher's may do temperature checks at the studio prior to entry)
- Masks required in all common areas including lobby/waiting room
- Students to sanitize hands prior to entry, bare feet will also be sanitized before Acro or Contemporary classes
- Waiting rooms are now closed in between classes and all seating has been removed
- Individual boot trays, dance bag storage and coat hooks for dancers
- In studio 6 ft by 6 ft assigned dance spaces
- Cleaning breaks in between classes, for sanitizing of frequently touched surfaces
- In Acro both instructor and student will wear face masks when spotting is required
- Paper cups have been removed from washrooms
- Antibacterial soap provided in washrooms
- The Dance Wear shop our dance apparel store is moving online. Beginning mid August, product will available in studio for purchase by appointment only.
