2018 Payment Options

Option One: Payment in Full

Payment in full for class fees and costumes at time of registration.

Methods of payment accepted include by cash, cheque, credit card or e-transfer. (Credit card processing is subject to convenience fee of 3%)

Option Two: Post-Dated Cheques

Class fees are divided into three equal installments and an additional costume payment. First installment is due at time of registration with registration fee by means of cash or cheque. The Dance Workshop must be provided with post-dated cheques for the remaining fees.

Second installment post-dated November 1st 2018

Costume fees post-dated December 1st 2018

Final installment post-dated February 1st 2019

Payment Conditions

Returned Cheques are subject to a \$25 Fee

Families with outstanding fees as of March 15th 2019 will not receive their child's recital costume(s) until their account is settled.

Refund Policy

Refunds will not be given for classes missed due to student illness or personal commitments.

Where a student sustains an injury that does not permit them to participate over an extended period of time (more than 6 weeks) a credit or refund will be issued. A doctor's note is required.

If a student wishes to drop a class before October 15th a refund will be issued for the remaining classes. After October 15 2018 refunds will not be issued.

Costume Fees are non-refundable.
