2021/2022 Payment Options

Registration Fees must be paid online by credit card at time of registration. If you do not hit the check-out button and pay the registration fee your dancer's spot in the class has not been saved and we cannot guarantee class availability. Fall session class fees are posted to accounts at the time of registration. Winter session class fees will be posted to accounts in December. Winter session costume fees will be posted to accounts in February 2022. A survey will be sent out in late November to confirm with dance families whether they wish to continue with their child's class in our winter session. You will not be required to re-register.



Option One: Payment in Full for Each Session

Payment in full for class fees.

Methods of payment accepted include cash, cheque, credit card or e-transfer. (Credit card processing is subject to convenience fee of 3%)

Option Two: Payment in Instalments

E-transfers (Please send to thedanceworkshopalliston@gmail.com, no password required)

Post-dated Cheques (Must be received by September 1st 2021)

Credit Card (subject to 3% service charge, paid on the parent portal)

Payments must be made on or before the due date or a late fee of \$5 will be applied to your account.

Important: Please label payments made by e-transfer and cheque with your dancer's name (first and last) and class. For example: John Doe, Kinder Hip Hop.

Calculating your Instalments and Due Dates

Class fees are divided into **two equal installments for each session.**

Fall Session

First instalment due September 1st 2021

Second instalment due November 1st 2021

Winter Session

First instalment due January 5th 2022

Second instalment and costume fees due March 1st 2022



Example: Sally is registered in Kinder Ballet. Her mom paid the \$20 registration fee online to save her spot and would like to pay in instalments by e-transfer. Her class fees are \$173.06 for the fall session \$173.06 divided by 2 = \$86.53

Sally's mom sends the following e-transfers to thedanceworkshopalliston@gmail.com In the subject line she adds Sally's name (first & last)

Sept 1 \$86.53 Nov 1 \$86.53

Sally's mom decides to continue with Sally's dance classes in our Winter session. Her class fees for the longer, 18 week winter session are \$222.50. Divided by 2 = \$111.50

Jan 5 \$ 111.50 March 1 \$176.50 (\$111.50 class fees + \$65 costume fee)

Costume Fees for Winter Session Dancers

A dance costume is a special outfit specifically for our year end recital. Dancers get to keep their costumes.

Changes to Our Payment Agreement due to COVID-19.

We are hopeful that our 2021/2022 season will be less eventful than last season. If we are mandated to close the studio, we will automatically switch to Zoom for 2 weeks. There will be no down time and all classes will run online at their scheduled times. After 2 weeks if we are unable to open, we will give our recreational dance families two options. (Two weeks of Zoom are built into both our fall and winter sessions.)

Option One: Dancer continues classes on Zoom with the goal of returning to in-studio classes. Instalment payments would continue as laid out in our payment plan.

Option Two: Withdrawal from classes. You will be reimbursed for any upcoming classes (excluding the agreed upon 2 weeks of Zoom classes) that you may have already paid for. In this case if you choose to withdraw from classes and we are able to resume in studio classes, we can no longer guarantee your child's spot in the class.

What if...? In the situation that a dance family does not feel comfortable attending classes at any point in the season but the studio is still allowed to operate while following all health and safety guidelines, we will offer zoom classes for that family. We have a zoom station set up and ready to go in each studio. Meeting ID and passwords will be sent out at the beginning of each session. Teachers will check for students online as they take class attendance.

Recital 2022

We plan to offer a recital to all our dancers to celebrate their achievements in mid-May 2022. It is still too early to know what our recitals may look like, but we are grateful to have a wonderful working relationship with the Nottawasaga Inn Resort where our recitals are held. We understand that depending on the situation in Ontario in 2022 families may not feel comfortable attending or having their dancer participate in a recital. As always, participation in recitals is encouraged but is optional. Each class presents one choreographed routine in either our Monday or Tuesday show.

Tentative Dress Rehearsal Dates: Mon May 9 2022 and Tues May 10 2022

Tentative Recital Dates: Mon May 16 and Tues May 17 2022



Costumes Payment

Costumes will not be ordered without payment, so please be sure to pay on-time. Costume fees are non-refundable. They are ordered with specific dancer's measurements in mind and cannot be returned to the costume company.

Families with outstanding fees as of March 10st 2022 will not receive their child's recital costume(s) until their account is settled. Families with an outstanding balance will be unable to purchase recital tickets online until their account is settled.

Refund Policy

Refunds will not be given for classes missed due to student illness or personal commitments.

Where a student sustains an injury that does not permit them to participate over an extended period of time (more than 6 weeks) a credit or refund will be issued. A doctor's note is required.

If a student wishes to drop a class, we require two weeks notice.

Costume Fees are non-refundable.

One snow day is built into the class fees for each session (fall and winter)
